Initially we spend about 15-20 minutes with the group as a whole providing history of the Light Station and some background information. Following this introduction, we take groups of approximately 5 up the tower to see the light and lens and take in the view. (The climb up the tower is a circular staircase of 36 steps which gets quite narrow at the top. There is a handrail.) **Backpacks, large bags, and packages are not permitted in the tower.**

Cameras and binoculars are acceptable. While awaiting your turn in the tower, you are welcome to wander the grounds. Of course, any individual may choose not to go up in the tower.

We will be glad to open the Interpretive Center for your visit. This building houses small historical exhibits and a video on the lighthouse and keepers.

We request no tours be given in conjunction with political events. Mukilteo Historical Society is a non-profit organization and will have no ties to political events. No tours will be given to preschoolers. Younger children are invited to visit with their parents on regular weekend tours. There is no charge for the tour, but all donations are greatly appreciated. These donations go towards the upkeep of the Light Station. We hope you enjoy your visit to Historic Mukilteo Light Station.
